WHY IS CHOCOLATE TOXIC TO PETS?

Theobromine, a substance found in the cacao seeds that are used to make chocolate, is not only deadly to dogs in heavy doses but can also have an adverse impact on canine health. Humans easily metabolize theobromine, but dogs process it much more slowly, allowing it to build up to toxic levels in their system.

FATAL DOSAGE LEVELS...

832MG
MINIMUM*

*Based on a 10kg dog. The fatal dosage can also depend on age, size and breed.

WHAT ARE THE SIGNS?

The key symptoms of a dog that has eaten chocolate are:

- Vomitting
- Diarrhea
- Hyperactivity
- Muscle twitching
- Restlessness
- Lethargy
- Excessive thirst
